Funding Context: 2010-11

- Over 31,000 applications requesting nearly £3 billion
- 14,000 awards totaling £400 million
- Actively managing a further 23,000 awards made in previous years

Open Air Laboratories is one of the Changing Spaces portfolio partners and aims to create and inspire a new generation of nature-lovers by getting people to explore, study, enjoy and protect their local environment.

The current climate



- Building on assets : needs versus ability to mobilise
- Future proofing : success yesterday doesn't guarantee success tomorrow

Supporting Change and Impact



- £50 million investment to offer short term help
- £10,000 grants for existing grant holders coming to end of their funding
- Up to one year's extra funding for the highest quality projects
- £17 million extra for Reaching Communities and Awards for All



Reaching Communities Buildings

- Aims to fund projects that improve or replace existing buildings where a wide range of community activities take place.
- Updates to make it run more effectively and increase number of eligible areas which can apply.
- Review next year.



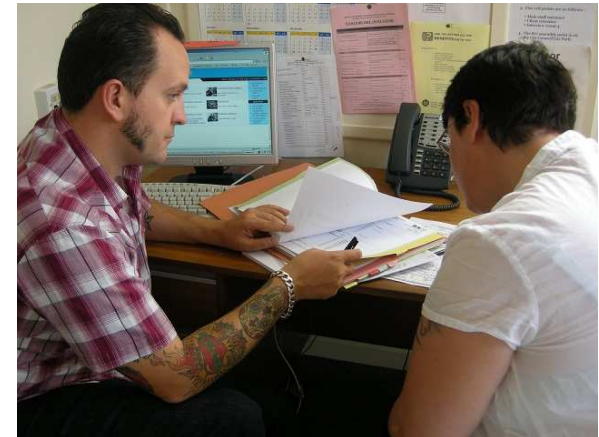
Building Capabilities

- Helping frontline voluntary organisations get the support they need, and maximise the impact of Lottery investment.
- Support can come from a variety of sources
- Co-ordinating with government, but complementary and additional
